FIVE UNIVERSITIES HONORED FOR INNOVATIVE FACILITIES PRACTICES

August 5, 2013, Alexandria VA – The winners of APPA's 2013 Effective & Innovative Practices Award were recognized Saturday for their programs and processes that enhance the delivery of services to their institutions.

The 2013 Awards recognize: Carleton University for “Rating The Sustainability Of Campus Facilities Management: A Foundation For Action Using ESAT”; University of California, Irvine for “UC Irvine Field Laboratory For Energy Studies”; Stanford University for “Stanford Energy System Innovations (SESI)”; Seattle University for “Professionals Without Borders (PWOB)”; and North Carolina State University for “NC State Facilities Management Feedback & Coaching Initiative.”

“It is an honor to recognize and reward these five university facilities management programs for their innovative work,” said David Cain, APPA’s Vice President, Professional Affairs, and the chair of the Awards and Recognition Committee.

Award nomination entries describe either a new program or significant restructuring of an existing program or process that lowered costs, increased productivity, improved customer service, generated revenue, or otherwise benefit the educational institution. The five winning submissions will be eligible for a \$4,000 cash award sponsored by Sodexo (SDXAY:OTC US).

The awards were presented on Saturday, August 3, during the Awards Banquet at the APPA 2013 Annual Conference and Exposition in Minneapolis.
